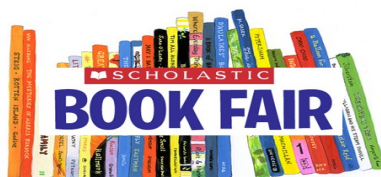


Friday Coffee Morning
