#### Notes from the Headteacher

#### Dear all,

I hope you like the format of the new newsletter, any feedback is always welcome! I am delighted to say that

the new term has started very positively with all the children really settled and enjoying their new topics.

Attendance has improved dramatically during January, but throughout December, attendance



slipped quite considerably and I just wanted to reinforce the importance of ensuring that your children are here every day and on time.

What might the impact of poor attendance be on your child?

- Attending school every day = 100% attendance
- Attending 4 1/2 days a week = 90% attendance
- = 4 weeks missed per year
- Attending 4 days a week = 80% attendance = more than half a term missed per year.
- Attending 3 1/2 days each week = 70% attendance = more than a quarter of the school year missed.
- An average attendance of 80% or less across a child's school career adds up to missing a whole 2 years from school.
- Being late for school reduces learning time.
- If your child is 5 minutes late every day they will miss three days of learning each year.
- If your child is 15 minutes late every day they will miss 2 weeks of learning each year.

Let's hope that we can work together to ensure that all children secure great attendance over the Spring Term so that they can really make great progress across all

areas of school life.
