POLLING DAY CLOSURES

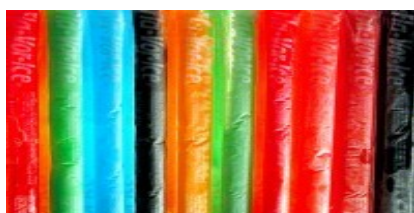
