We are looking at definitions of the two values, then thinking of how we can develop hope and trust within ourselves and also show the values in both school and our community. We are also looking at learning about hope and trust from the Bible, as well as other stories, texts, religions and cultures.



# LEARNING TO LEARN WEEK

This week at St Peter's, we have had our Learning to Learn Week - unlocking potential in all. We have themed each day, ensuring that we are giving our children the foundations for unlocking their potential.

Our first day back started off by setting routines and our high expectations for the children, deciding on class charters and discussing what positive learning behaviour might look like. We have explored avenues the children have at school to support their mental well-being and identified ways the children can ask for help if they need support for themselves or for a friend.

Our second day has been all about careers! We have discussed in an age appropriate way with the children about what jobs they may want in the future or the skills they might need to flourish in a certain job. We have begun to look at CVs and to discuss what we might include in one. In the older year groups, we have begun to explore gender stereotypes and how it is important to challenge these.

Our third day was all about people who inspire us. Our houses are named after 4 people who inspire St Peter's pupils and staff: Marcus Rashford, Greta Thunberg, Rosa Parks and David Attenborough. We have been talking about other people who inspire us and using a philosophy for children approach to dig deeper into what inspirational means to us!

Our final day was exciting! We had our well deserved treat to Playzone for our amazing hard work when OFSTED visited us.

#### UNIFORM REMINDER
