Year 4

Multiplication and Division

- Recalling times table facts up to 12×12
- Multiplying and dividing by 0 and 1
- Using written methods to work out a 3-digit number multiplied by a 1-digit number.

Measurement

- Finding the area of rectilinear shapes.

Fractions and decimals

- Investigating equivalent fractions and decimals
- Counting up and down in hundredths
- Using fractions to calculate quantities where the answer is a whole number.
- Adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator.
- Recognising that a decimal has been divided by 10 or 100 and knowing the value of each of these digits.
- Simple measure problems involving fractions and decimals to 2 decimal places.
