
### Communication and Language

This term in Little Learners we will be focusing on:

- Understanding 'who', 'what' and 'where' questions.
- Developing our recall of stories we hear and joining in with stories with a pattern.
- Continuing to build up a wide range of vocabulary which is linked to our learning.

#### Mathematics

Little Learners will be learning to:

- Count how many fingers we have on each hand and counting up to ten using our fingers.
- Look at the shape and size of dinosaur footprints and count in a variety of ways.
- Using positional language to direct others.
- Mark making numbers in and around Little Learners.
- Working out when we have more, less or the same.

#### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Extend our conversations in role play with others.
- Developing our confidence in talking to others in larger groups and using talk to explain our thinking to others.
- Working together to take turns, share and help each other.
- Develop the ability to adapt behavior to different events and situations.

#### Literacy

This term in Little Learners we are focusing on:

- Enjoying a wide range of books including Dinosaur Roar, Harry and the Bucketful of Dinosaurs, The Hungry Caterpillar and Jasper's Beanstalk. We will be listening to stories and looking at them independently.
- Joining in with repeated refrains and anticipating key events and phrases in rhymes and stories.
- Finding words in our environment and giving meaning to marks we find around us.

- Finding out about Chinese New Year and Easter
- Using computers to find out more
- Finding out about our environment, growing plants, looking after our world.

#### Physical Development

- Find out about the effect of activity on our bodies.
- Move around in different ways using music and different stories such as 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'.
- Showing control in using a range of equipment including tools and large and small play equipment.





#### **Expressive Arts and Design** In Little Learners, we will be:

- Joining in with dancing and ring games.
- Singing familiar and new songs.
- Developing movement in response to music and creating rhythms.
- Exploring colours and how colours can be changed.
- Talking about our pictures and models.
- Making a wide range of exciting creations and baking!
