RE

Y1- Spring 1- God (Islam) – making connections between two different religions, exploring the similarities and differences.

Year 1

Literacy

Reading – develop knowledge and understanding of digraphs which make up words. Continuing to work on blending sounds within words and developing fluency within reading.

Writing – continuing to orally dictate sentences before writing them, ensuring that sentences make sense. Accurate use of capital letters and full stops within writing, ensuring capital letters are formed correctly. Using the conjunction 'and' within a sentence.

Handwriting - focusing on holding a pencil accurately. Developing cursive letter formation with particular emphasis on letters sitting on the line. Accurate formation of capital letters, ensuring they are an appropriate size.

- adding numbers within 20

<u>Literacy</u>

Reading – reading accurately by blending sounds, self-correcting mistakes and developing fluency. Developing inference skills and the enjoyment of reading.

Writing – developing the use of coordinating and subordinating conjunctions to extend sentences. Using a variety of punctuation accurately, including capital letters, full stops, question marks and apostrophes. Using and applying spelling patterns and spelling y2 common exception words accurately.

Handwriting – focusing on consistent cursive letter formation and correct letter sizes, with a specific focus on tall letters when joining letters.
