## Physical Development

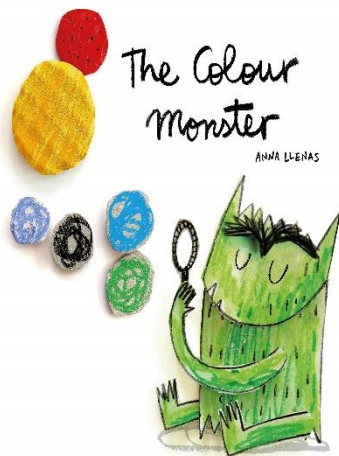
Little Learners are learning to:

## Literacy

This term in Little Learners we are focusing on:

- Enjoying a wide range of books including books about celebrations, The Colour Monster, Ruby's Worry and My Amazing Body.
- Giving meaning to the marks we make as we draw and paint.
- Mark making for different reasons, such as writing in cards or menus and taking orders in our role play.
- Writing letters (adult scribing) to ask for things they would like and using our post-box.



## Mathematics

Little Learners will be learning to:

- Confidently recite zero to ten.
- Select a small number of objects from a group when asked, for example, 'please give me two'.
- Compare heights
- Sing number songs and rhymes
- Counting how many fingers we have on each hand and counting up to ten using our fingers.
- Enjoy playing with numbers and shapes in our environment.

## Understanding of the World

In Little Learners, we will be:

- Looking at what makes us special and unique
- Finding out about ourselves and our families
- Exploring our environment and asking questions.
- Exploring different celebrations in different cultures.
- Looking after our environment and caring for our guinea pigs.

## Expressive Arts and Design

In Little Learners, we will be:

- Joining in with dancing and ring games.
- Singing familiar and new songs.
- Exploring colours and how colours can be changed.
- Talking about our pictures and models.
- Engaging in imaginative role-play based on our own experiences, including celebrations.
- Exploring different celebrations-dancing, creating art and music!
