RE

<u>Values</u>

<u>Spring 1-</u> This term the children will focus on friendship and forgiveness. The children will explore what this looks like in the bible and in the community.

<u>Spring 2-</u> This term the children will focus on the value of justice, making links with classroom rules. The children will explore justice in our world through charities such as Red Nose Day.

History/ Geography

Children will be learning about the history of transport and key famous figures who have influenced transport over the years. We will create a timeline of when cars, trains and airplanes were invented. The children will then compare different transport and have the opportunity to share how they have changed over the years.

PHSE

We will be following the programme Zippy's Friends. In Year 1 we will be exploring ways to use and improve our listening skills. We will also focus on ways to communicate with our friends. In Year 2 we will be looking at how to be a good friend to others. We will focus on resolving conflicts and talking about how we can cope with loneliness.

PE

Over this term we will be focusing on fitness and stamina. We will use our Sport's Padlet to participate in different online workouts such as Born to Move and Get Kids Moving, Cosmic yoga and other interactive activities.

Music

At home, the children will be using the Oak Academy learning clips to join in with and explore music using their voices. Y1- We will be using the Charanga unit Round and Round to explore music, improvise using instruments and explore composition and performance. Y2 – Children will be exploring a Rock song called ' I Wanna Play In A Band'. We will learn to play together in an ensemble using improvisation and ending with a performance.
