Reading	Data shows not a huge gap in attainment in reading, but as a reading school, this is an area of high priority. Staff CPD is being accessed through the LEAP programmes, but money needs to go on high quality resources to back up effective teaching.	£2000 for books esp. Read, write, inc.	£2000
