Reading

- Fluency of reading - developing our fluency using our knowledge of digraphs to read with increased speed.
- Begin using the 6P's to read aloud accurately.
- Answer simple retrieval questions using the text and pictures to support their answers.
- Give a brief summary of the text they have read.
- Begin self-correcting errors within their reading ensuring that what they have read makes sense.
- Continuing to learn all initial phonics sounds and digraphs.

Writing and Grammar

- I remember when - poetry focus learning how to use 2 adjectives and a noun.
- Supertato - Writing a story where a hero defeats a villain or monster focusing on using the conjunctions 'because', and 'and' so to extend sentences and some 'ly' words to describe how a character moves within the story.
- Meerkat Mail - Creating an information report about an Australian animal. Continue to develop use of conjunctions and begin using question marks to demarcate a question.

Spelling

- A making the 'or' sound
- C making the 's' sound if placed before i/e/y
- 'j' sound at the end of a word spelt as 'dge'
- Suffix ly - change the y for an i at the end of words
- O making the 'u' sound
- Keeping the 'y' and adding 'ing'
- Adding -ing to words ending in e
- Double the consonant when adding suffix -ed
- Suffix ment and ness
- Le and el endings
- Silent kn
- Possessive apostrophes for singular nouns

Maths

- Place value - the value of digits in numbers to 100
- Addition and subtraction - adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers crossing 10
