Years 5 Autumn term 2022

RF

This term, Year 5 will be learning about core Hindu and Islamic beliefs and how these impact on the lives of individuals and build a sense of community. Y5 will some opportunities to discuss their ideas and thoughts in a Philosophy for Children approach.

Computing

At the beginning of the term, Y5 will using a range of programmes to practice and develop their coding skills. In addition, Y5 will have the opportunity to create spread sheets using excel. Towards the end of the term, Y5 will be exploring how to keep safe on the internet.

History and Geography

Our topic this term centres around the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England. We will be looking closely at key events and individuals during this time period, including the Viking raid on Lindisfarne and archaeological discoveries that tell us more about this time period, including the finds at Sutton Hoo.

PSHE and Values

Y5 will be covering the topic relationships. In this topic, we will be exploring what a healthy/unhealthy relationship might look like, looking at what peer influence is and how to be assertive in different situations.

This year, Y5 will be swimming every Tuesday afternoon at NK.

At school, children will be focusing on the personal development strand where they will have the opportunity to set goals for themselves. They will be developing their ball skills and being able to balance with a partner

Science

This term in science, children will be exploring these big questions:

Autumn I - Why can some solutions be reversed? How can we reverse changes? What methods can we use? Autumn 2- Which forces has the greatest effect on a falling object: air resistance or gravity? Focusing on working scientifically and creating investigations

Art and DT

Autumn I art - Y5 will be developing their drawing skills in an 'I need space' topic.

Autumn 2 - Y5 will be using paint mixed media art to create some quirky portraits.

DT – Y5 will be developing their knowledge around structures to create a purposeful shelter which they will plan, create and evaluate.

Music

In music this term, we are working with the Lincolnshire Music Service.

Year 5 will be learning how to play trumpets and trombones.
