Year 1 Autumn term 2023

<u>RE</u>

This term we will be focusing on Christianity. We will be learning about Christian's beliefs about God and how they show love to God. We will also be learning about the Christian story of creation.

Computing

We will be learning how to log on to the computers and how to access a range of activities on Purple Mash.

We will be developing our mouse control skills and use of the keyboard.

<u>Art/ DT</u>

<u>Art-</u> We will be experimenting with media and using these different media to make marks and draw. We will also be using paints to explore colour mixing and printing. We will be using our skills to create artwork in the style of Clarice Cliff. <u>DT-</u> We will be designing and building freestanding models of playground equipment (such as a slide or swing).

<u>History</u>

We will be looking closely at Lincoln castle, learning about the different features and comparing this to different types of castle. We will be exploring the key events in the history of Lincoln castle and learning about key historical figures including William the Conqueror.

<u>Science</u>

This term we will be learning about everyday materials. We will be focusing on naming and describing and sorting different materials, finding out the properties of different materials and exploring what materials are best for different purposes.

Geography

We will be learning about Lincoln and exploring our local area. We will be exploring the physical and human features of our local area and will be exploring how to create and use maps to help us navigate around the local area.

Reading and Phonics

During Autumn term, we will focus on learning all the initial phonics sounds, diagraphs (sounds made up of two letters) and practice blending for reading. Children will have daily Read, Write Inc. phonics sessions and additional whole class phonics and reading sessions. We will work on improving fluency and comprehension skills.

Writing

During the Autumn Term we will be focusing on the foundations of writing, including the use of capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will develop our vocabulary, explore sentence structure and use these skills to write for different purposes. We will be exploring the books 'The Enormous Turnip' and 'How to Catch a star' and through Talk4Writing we will produce exciting stories with cumulative plots and learn to write instructions.

Spelling

During the Autumn Term we will focus on learning to spell tricky words. We will then focus on some of the key spelling rules for year 1 such as adding 's' or 'es' to words to make a plural and the following spelling patterns:

- Words ending with 'ff'
- Words ending with 'ss'
- Words ending with 'll'
- Words ending with 'zz'

Handwriting

We will be learning how to form letters and numbers correctly and with the correct size and placement. We will also apply our letter formation by writing high frequency words.
