History and Geography

Our topic this term centres around the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England. We will be looking closely at key events and individuals during this time period, including the Viking raid on Lindisfarne and archaeological discoveries that tell us more about this time period, including the finds at Sutton Hoo.

<u>Science</u>

This term in science, children will be exploring these big questions:

We will be exploring different drawing techniques and the concept of retrofuturism. We will be using paint mixed media art to create some quirky portraits. DT – Y5 will be developing their knowledge around structures to create a purposeful shelter which they will plan, create and evaluate.
