Year 1 Spring term 2024 - 2025

Wheels, wings and other things

Which development in transport was the most important to society? Why?

<u>History</u>

Children will be learning about the history of transport and famous figures who have influenced transport through history. Children will be exploring cars, trains, airplanes and space travel. We will be comparing different types of transport and learn how they have changed over the years.

<u>PE</u>

<u>Spring 1 – We will be following the</u> creative cog focusing on balancing on a line and our static balance focus is our stance.

<u>Spring 2 – We will be following the</u> creative cog with a focus on coordination and ball skills. We will be strengthening our balance further through counterbalancing with a partner.

Throughout the term, we will be supported by Lincoln City within PE who will be developing our balance and jumping and landing skills within gymnastics.

Computing

We will be using 'Purple Mash' to explore coding. We will learn how to use code blocks to create a set of instructions and how to use codes to create a simple computer program.

<u>Science</u>

Seasons - We will be learning about the different seasons, including exploring the changes in the length of day and the differences in weather in each season.

Plants - We will be learning about the key parts of a plant and exploring the different kinds of wild plants, garden plants and trees.

<u>PHSE</u>

Through the programme 'Zippy's Friends' we will be exploring our feelings, including feeling jealous and nervous. We will be exploring ways to use and improve our listening skills, and ways to communicate our needs and how to ask for help. We will also explore using the internet safely and look at jobs in the local community.

<u>Music</u>

We will be exploring pitch and tempo. We will be making patterns with two different pitches and creating superhero theme tunes. We will also be learning and using lots of different musical vocabulary.

<u>RE</u>

This term, we will be learning about the religion of Islam. We will be learning about the key Muslim beliefs and finding out about the importance of prayer and the mosque to the Muslim community. We will also be learning about the special festivals of Eid ul-Adha and Eid ul-Fitr

<u>Art/ DT</u>

<u>Art-</u>This term, we will be exploring sculpture and 3D artwork. We will be learning how to shape and use paper to create 3D pictures. We will then explore how to create a sculpture as a group using the paper shaping techniques.

<u>DT-</u> We will be exploring wheels and axels. We will be designing and making a moving vehicle.

<u>Values</u>

Spring 1 – Our first value is friendship and forgiveness. We will be exploring what friendship is and how Jesus showed friendship in the bible. We will link this with showing forgiveness and discuss what forgiveness means.

Spring 2 – Our second value is justice. During our values lessons, we will think about what justice is and how we can show it. We will discuss the difference between being fair and showing justice, linking it with stories from the bible.
